

Happy Camper Lantern Instructions



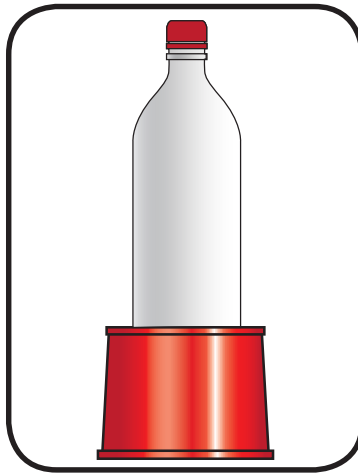
Supplies*:

- 2 liter soda bottle
- Red tin or plastic bucket
- Red plastic cup
- Red plastic bowl
- Insulation board or cardboard
- Scissors
- Utility knife
- Drill
- LED tea light
- Hot glue gun
- Red and brown pipe cleaners
- Orange and red tissue paper
- Red paint

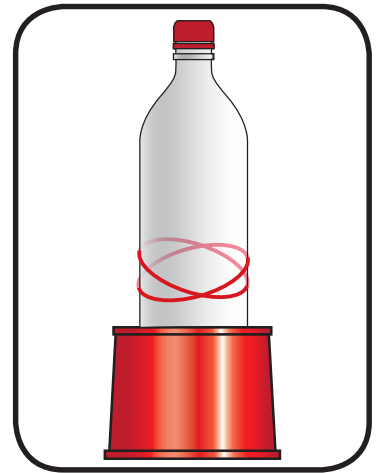
Directions:



1. Cut off the bottom of the 2 liter soda bottle with a utility knife. *(For safety purposes, we recommend wearing leather gloves when using the utility knife. Never leave the utility knife where children can pick it up.)*

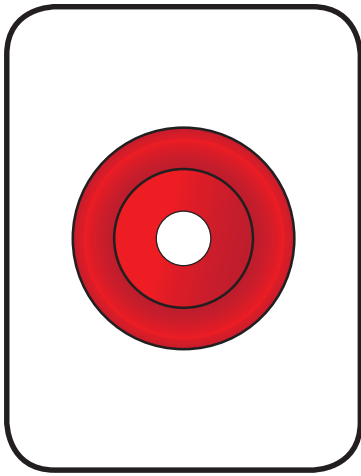


2. Remove the handle on the red bucket. Turn the bucket upside down and place the 2 liter bottle on top.

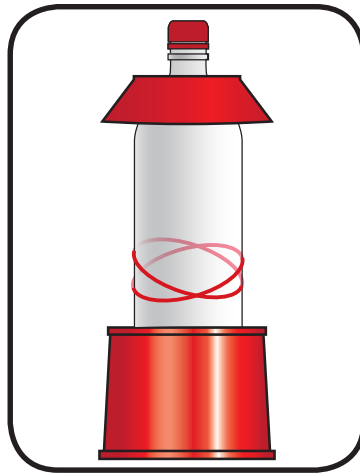


3. Wrap two strands of red pipe cleaner around the bottom of the bottle. Hot glue in place.

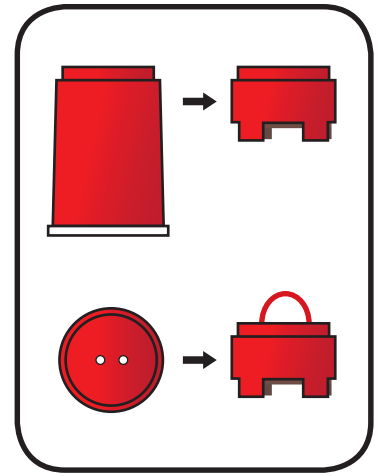
*Remember, these are only suggestions. This project should be fun and creative, so use supplies you have on hand for substitutions.



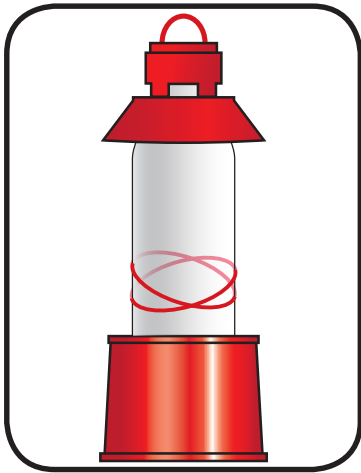
4. Cut a hole into the center of a plastic red bowl.



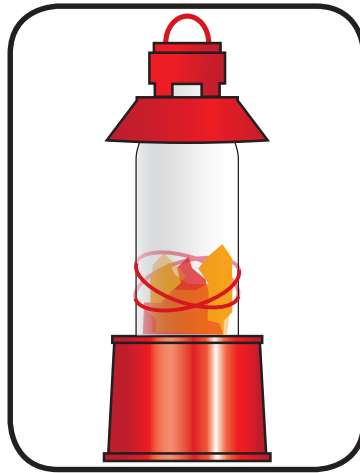
5. Place the bowl face down onto the top of the bottle. Glue in place.



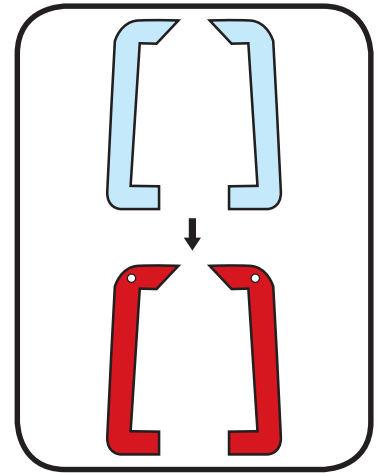
6. Cut a plastic red cup in half. Then cut out four squares around the opening. Drill two holes into the bottom of the cup and insert a red pipe cleaner through the holes. Tie the ends to form a ring and hot glue into place.



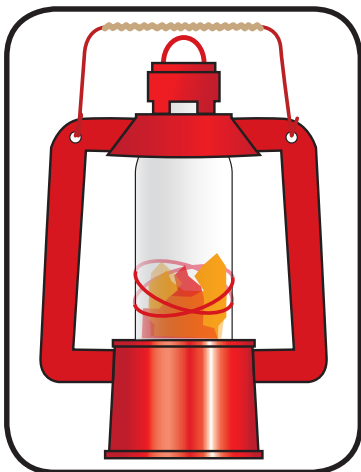
7. Place the cup piece on the top of the bottle and hot glue the bottom edges to the bowl.



8. Place a LED tea light in the bottle and surround the light with orange and red tissue paper.



9. Cut out the two handle shapes from insulation board or cardboard. Paint the two shapes red and drill a hole in the top of each.



10. Hot glue the two handle shapes to the sides of the red bowl. Tie the ends of a red pipe cleaner to the holes to create a handle. Wrap a brown pipe cleaner around the center of the red handle.
